Introduction:

For the first time in the history of Pakistan, the Inter Board Committee of Chairmen conducted IBCC Inter Board Regional (Boys & Girls) Qirrat, Naat, Urdu Speech and National Songs Competition 2021 across the country under the directions of Mr. Shafqat Mahmood, the Federal Minister for Education and Professional Training (FE&PT). The IBCC organized these competitions in collaboration with Inter Board Sports Committee (IBSC) and Inter University Consortium. The Inter Board Sports Committee coordinates with all the regional organizers and makes sure the presence of all boards and participants, while Inter University Consortium assists in matters related to universities like arrangement of venue, provision of judges and facilitate other necessary arrangements at universities.

The IBCC organized these competitions in seven regions of Pakistan from February 18, 2021 to March 9, 2021. As per the schedule the first regional competition was held at Islamia University Bahawalpur on February 18, 2021 and the regional organizer of this competition was BISE Bahawalpur. The second competition was held at the University of Punjab, Lahore on February 22, 2021 and the organizer was BISE Lahore. The regional organizer of the third region is BISE Larkana and it was held on February 24, 2021 at SZABIST College Larkana. The fourth regional competition was held at the Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education, Peshawar on March 1, 2021, BISE Peshawar was the organizer of region four. The fifth regional competition was held at Pak-Austria Fachhochschule: Institute of Applied Sciences and Technology, Mang, Haripur, Pakistan on March 4, 2021, BISE Swat was the regional organizer. Iqra University, Karachi hosts the sixth regional competition on March 6, 2021 and the regional organizer of this region was the Sindh Board of Technical Education (SBTE), Karachi. The final regional competition was held on March 9, 2021 at National Skill University, Islamabad and the regional organizer of this region was BISE Rawalpindi.

IBCC Inter Board Boys & Girls Competitions (Region I) March 6, 2021:

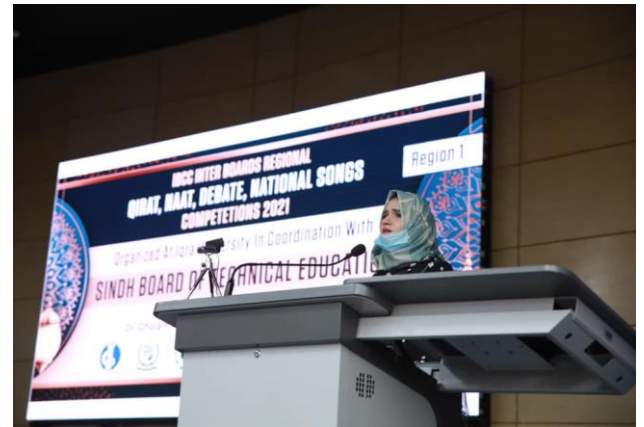
